- Each Team/gymnast is obligated to send at least one judge (highest national level)
- If no judge is sent, a fee of: 150 € per Team, for single gymnasts: 50 € has to be paid.
- It is possible to **register**
 - o individual gymnasts only
 - \circ a team or
 - o a team and individual gymnasts
- Insurance: for the insurance of the participants, each club / federation is responsible
- A Team can be send by a Club, a Gym, a Region or a Nation. You are free to choose a name for the team
- The entry fee is 80 € per team or 30 € per individual gymnast
- The entry fee will be invoiced immediately after the registration deadline. You have to pay latest in the week of the competition or







by cash at the competition. A medal ceremony will be held for each AgeGroup and additionally for the Team competition and the Apparatus Finals.

- In each **AgeGroup**, the 8 gymnasts with the highest score will qualify for the **Apparatus Finals**. A maximum of 2 gymnasts per Nation are allowed to compete in the finals. If less than 8 gymnasts are qualified because of that rule, the next best gymnasts will be qualified, even if there are more than 2 of one nation
- The first 3 gymnasts (all around) and the first 3 Teams will be awarded with a Cup.
- A team consists of maximum 4 gymnasts who can be of different age groups. At each apparatus a maximum number of 4 gymnast are allowed to compete. The best 3 scores will be taken for the teamscore
- In order to get a fair team score over all AGs, the **younger gymnasts will get a bonus** for the team calculation.
 - A gymnast AG 12/13 will receive 1 point bonus in total
 - A gymnast AG 11 and younger will receive 2 points bonus in total

With sending the registration you agree that fotos and videos of the competition may be used for publicity.

One or two gymnasts per team have the chance for free cancellation or change of the name (for competition and Hotel) until 30.05.2024, 8.p.m.

The finals will be finished until 2.p.m. on Sunday so that the most teams will be able to get home on Sunday.

There are a few rooms booked in the <u>Hotel Plaza</u> (next to Hannover main station) Teams arrinving in Hannover by train or airplane will get transport to Hotel and Gym for free.
